### Saturday 21 October

#### Two Guided Talks

Two talks on the history and environment around the 800 year old St. Andrew's Church, each lasting about 1hr.

Meet at St Andrew's church at 10am and 2pm

#### Family Treasure Hunt

An opportunity to explore Congresbury. Starting from Congresbury Community Library and finishing at the Refectory.

Start time between 10am and 2pm.

#### Refectory

Visit the Refectory, one of the oldest buildings in the village.

#### Cadbury Hill Display

Congresbury Community Library will host a display on the history of Cadbury Hill.

#### Strawberry Line Walk

A walk along the Strawberry Line, looking at the history of the railway in Congresbury.

#### Boundary Stones Walk

A 6 mile walk from Congresbury through the woods to Wrington and back along the River Yeo, looking at some of the parish boundary stones with archaeologist Vince Russett.

Walk starts at 10:30am from The Star, Rhyodate Hill.

Suitable footwear and a packed lunch are recommended. Dogs on leads are welcome

Please park in the Riverside Car Park where Bluey, our community bus, will be available from 10am to transport walkers to the start of the walk.
