# Surgery in Eighteenth Century Bristol

This study sets sketches of half a dozen Bristol surgeons against the background of medical profession of the time. Technically surgeons ranked below physicians in status, but these men might enjoy great reputation as their apprentice lists and fees demonstrate. Nor was their work limited to surgical intervention; and the detailed and well-documented accounts of individual cases here enlarge our knowledge of the medical practice of the time.

**Michael Whitfield** was senior lecturer in General Practice in the University of Bristol. In his retirement he has devoted himself to the history of medical practice in nineteenth-century Bristol, and is author of ALHA Books No 4 *Dr Goodeve and Cook's Folly*, No 9 *The Bristol Microscopists*, No 15 *Homoeopathy in Bristol*, No 26 *Richard Smith: Bristol Surgeon and Medical Collector 1772-1843*, No 28 *The Surgeons and the Bristol School of Artists*, No 31 *Resident Hospital Apothecaries in Georgian Bristol*; as well as co-author of No 19 *Public Health in Victorian Bristol*.
